Helga Dietrich is one of the world’s foremost experts in early-years music education. She is a graduate of the Liszt Academy (Budapest) and became a certified teacher of solfège, singing and violoncello in 1972. She has been a Lecturer in Pedagogy on the Faculty of Primary and Pre-School Education of the Music Department of Eötvös Loránd University in Budapest since 1986, teaches regularly for the Kodály Pedagogical Institute in Kecskemét, and has offered demonstration lessons at the International Kodály Symposium 2013. She has travelled extensively abroad and taught on a variety of courses and workshops around the world, including for: the Kodály Centre of America; the Organization of American Kodály Educators; the Holy Names Kodály Summer Institute (California); the Kodály Music Education Institute of Australia; the Kodály Institute of Britain; the British Kodály Academy; the National Youth Choir of Scotland; and Dogs and Birds (UK). This is her second course for Stepping Notes.

This course will concentrate on:

- fostering and encouraging musical creativity in very young children (aged 3 to 7),
based upon and working from the ideas and concepts of Zoltán Kodály;
- vocal improvisation with children;
- communicating with children through song and rhythmic speech;
- developing children’s understanding of rhythm, musical phrasing and melody.
